

Beginning Quilting: Jelly Roll Christmas Tree Quilt Jennifer Morgan Moore's of Mission Viejo Mondays, May 7, 14, June 4, 11, & 18 6:00pm-9:00p



Supply List:

- *Sewing Machine with 1/4" presser foot or some way to sew with a consistent 1/4" seam allowance.
- *Basic sewing supplies: seam ripper, straight pins, scissors, etc.
- *Rotary cutter and mat.
- *Rulers: Bring what you have, I used a 6" x 24" and a 6" x 12". If you have a 15" or larger square ruler, bring it as well to square up the large block.
- *Size One safety pins for pin-basting your quilt for quilting (the curved ones are best, but the non-curved ones are fine).
- *Cotton sewing thread (50 weight) in a neutral color (gray or cream usually work) for piecing, and thread for guilting to match your fabric (we will discuss color and type in class).
- *Tape measure which shows the 1/8" marks clearly.
- Fabric marking pen or pencil. We will discuss this further in class.
- *Fabric: I used a jelly roll to make the Christmas Trees, and supplemented with strips I

cut from yardage. A jelly roll is a pre-packaged bundle of fabrics that are already cut into $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips. I separated the jelly roll into colors, and ended up using about 6 - 9 different fabrics per color family, (red, green, gold) for a total of approximately 25 strips. However, you can use yardage for all the trees.

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• Decide how many colors of trees you want. I used three, but you may use just two, make all the trees the same color, or use more than three colors, its up to you. For the first class we will work on one tree, so have enough fabric to complete one tree. A good starting point is to have about 5 fabrics, ¼ yard each. Please email me if you have questions about yardage!

Background: 3 yards.

Backing: 3 1/2 yards

Binding: ½ yard

*Batting: 62" x 70" or 1 3/4 yards of 90" batting on the roll
