## **Supply List:**

- Book: Seasonal Silhouettes by Edyta Sitar\*
- One Fat ¼ for each wall hanging. If using for all 12 you will need 2 yards\*
- ¼ vd for outer border\*
- ¼ yd for inner border and binding\*
- Fabric for appliques-Fat ¼'s and scraps work great for this project
- Backing is a 20" X 24" piece for each wall hanging. Fat ¼'s will not work for this project. Total 4½ yds for all 12. If you wish to cut your background fabric I cut mine 13½" X 17½".
- Batting-20 X 24 piece
- Any two-sided fusible web. I prefer Steam-A-Seam II or Pellon Lite EZ Steam II. It comes in 8½" X 11" sheets or on a roll.\*
- Pencil for tracing. The fusible web strongly suggests using a pencil and after lots of smearing we now know why.
- Rotary mat, rotary cutter and ruler\*
- Sewing Machine and Manual
- Basic Sewing Supplies including scissors, pins, seam ripper and other tools you Prefer\*
- Walking Foot.
- Thread: Good 50W cotton thread for piecing. Thread for quilting. Optional: Decorative thread, Perle Cotton, Floss, Bling and Beads.

Light box or light pad.

- Small sharp to the tip scissors for cutting fabric\*
- Small sharp to the tip scissors for paper\*
- Grab your supplies, your enthusiasm and let's get started.
- If you wish to try some appliqué with your embroidery machine please talk to the staff at the store or contact the instructor.
