



Class Supply List

Winter Fun Table Runner

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Moore's of Brea

Saturday, December 10th

9:30 a.m. – 4 p.m.



There are two options for this project - simple or with a strip border. Border is done in the hoop.

Supply List:

- * Embroidery Machine, accessories, proper bobbin & needles
Sewing assembly, presser foot, proper bobbin & needles
- * Hoop - best size is 8" x 12"
- * No Show Mesh stabilizer to fit your hoop
- * Embroidery threads white, red, blue, brown, black, orange colors to match fabric for scarf and complement quilt block background
- * Sewing Thread - Color to coordinate with fabric color.
- * Scissors – Sharp scissors for cutting fabric, appliqué scissors
- * Rotary cutter with blade and ruler. Cutting mat
- * Sewing pins or clips
- Fabrics – White, black, background of block, scarf, hat band. Small prints work best
- Quilt batting with thin loft
- *Removable tape or Spray Adhesive 505 (optional)

Precut Fabric – Quality cotton is best

Quilt block background - 9 ½" – 10" square. Cut for the number of blocks you want for your project. I used blue fabric.

Snowflake – Cut white fabric 8" x 8" Add SF101 stabilizer to the back of fabric.

Snowman – Cut white fabric 6" x 6 ½" Add SF101 stabilizer to the back of fabric

Hat fabric 3 ½" x 3 ½", hat band 1" x 2 ½", scarf 3 ½" x 5"

Add SF101 stabilizer to the back of fabric (optional)

Strip Borders – Cut several blue strips 8 ½" x 2", cut several white strips 8 ½" x 2"

Set one 5 blue strips, 4 white strips. Set two 5 white strips, 4 blue strips.

One of each set will frame one block. Repeat for the number of blocks you want for project.
