Supply List:

- * Embroidery Machine & accessories
- * Sewing assembly, needle, presser foot, ¼" sewing foot if you have one
- * Hoop size 8" x 12" minimum
- * No Show Mesh stabilizer to fit your hoop
- USB to put embroidery files on
- * Embroidery thread – colors that coordinate with fabric
- * Sewing Thread – Colors that coordinate with fabric
- * Scissors – Bent appliqué scissors
- * Sewing pins or clips
- * Rotary cutter with blade, ruler, cutting mat
- * SF101 woven interfacing or Fusible woven stabilizer
- * Removable tape, glue stick or Spray Adhesive 505 (optional)
- Pressing cloth
- Fabric for project, quality cotton is best.

Preparation:

Precut Fabric: Small prints or tone on tone work best. Scraps work great for centers of flowers. Use two to three different green fabrics for leaves.

Block Base

Cut four 10" x 10" White – tone on tone fabric for quilt block base

Adhere SF101 interfacing to back of white squares

Corners for **each** block cut two 3" x 3" squares, cut diagonally in half.

Flowers (see as numbered in photo)

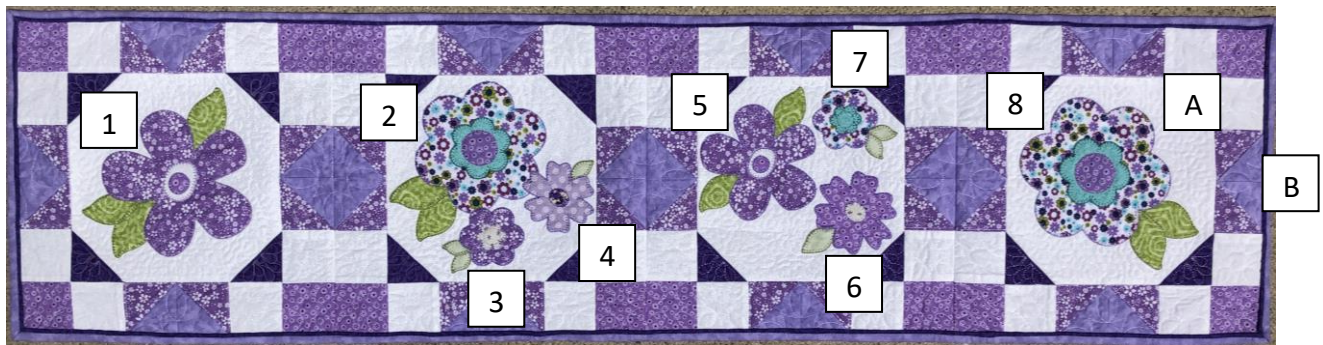
1. (1) 7"x 7" piece of fabric for large flower, scraps for center circles
(3) 2" x 3" pieces of green fabric for leaves.
2. (1) 5 ½" – 6" piece of fabric for large flower, (1) center 3 ½" x 3 ½"
(1) center circle 2" x 2", (2) 2" x 3" pieces of green for leaves.
3. (1) 3" x 3" piece fabric for flower, scrap for center of flower,
(2) 1 ½" x 1" green for leaves.
4. (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" piece fabric for flower, scrap for center of flower, (1) 1 ½" x 1" green for leaf.
5. (1) 5 ½" x 5 ½" piece of fabric for large flower, scraps for center circles,
(2) 2" x 3" pieces of green fabric for leaves.
6. (1) 4"x 4" piece fabric for flower, scrap for center of flower, (1) 1 ½" x 1" green for leaf.
7. (1) 3"x 3" piece fabric for flower, (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" piece fabric for center, (2) 1 ½" x 1" green for leaves.
8. (1) 6 ½"x 6 ½" piece of fabric for large flower (1) center fabric 3 ½" x 3 ½",
center circle 2" x 2", (2) 2" x 3" pieces of green for leaves.

Borders These instructions make one set of borders. Cut fabric for as many borders as you need.

Cut fabric for squares 2 ¾" x 2 ¾". (4) for corners – purple, (8) for sides – white.

Cut fabric for triangles 3" x 3" square, then cut diagonally to make triangles (see as labeled in photo)

A: (4) outer triangles B: (4) inner triangles that make diamond
