### **Supply List:**

\*Embroidery and sewing machine in good working order with power cord, hoops and instruction manual

Design – must be purchased from Designs By JuJu. The SKU is DBJJITH345 Nautical Table Runner

\*Embroidery thread to match the design. A listing of the colors follows.

\*Stabilizer - I recommend using a No Show mesh type

\*Sewing and embroidery supplies such as curved scissors, duck bill scissors, filled bobbins, ruler, rotary cutter, etc.

\*Embroidery hoops. I used a 9.5" x 9.5" for the larger blocks and a 5" x 7" for some of the smaller blocks.

\*Batting: There are 16 designs that require a 4" x 11" piece of batting. Five designs require an 8" x 11" piece of batting. A piece of 16" x 42" batting is required for the back of the completed table runner after it was sewn together

\* Backing fabric (42" x 16") and binding (If you purchase a kit, the binding is included)

\*Basting Spray

\*Walking foot for your machine

\*Thread colors: Red, cream, white, light blue, medium blue, dark blue, medium brown, black, yellow gold, peach, light tan, medium gray, black, light teal, dark teal medium green

I used Invisible thread with a bobbin in a color that matched the backing to stitch in the ditch when the project was sewn together.
