## **Supply List:**

- \*Your own sewing machine
- \* ¼" sewing foot for your machine
- \* Quilting pins
- \* Neutral quilting threads for the bobbins as well.
- \* Sewing scissors
- \* Rotary cutter and a travel cutting mat
- \* Basic quilting rulers
- \* Travel iron and a travel iron mat
- \* #2 pencil and a white chalk marking tool
- \* Your basic auilting tool kit.
- \* Background fabric for all blocks (I recommend that you purchase 5 yards ahead of class - or - you can plan to use various white/cream fabrics or lights as a background. It is up to you what color you want the background to be. Whatever you plan on using please bring to the first class at least a fat guarter or 1/4 yard.
- \* Star Point Fabric You will need a fat quarter of a yellow fabric for your star's center. This fabric should coordinate with your star point fabric. You can pick a focal point

fabric for the center & then coordinate to the star point fabrics.

\* Fabrics listed on the class handout. (First class handout will be available when you sign up for class, other months handouts will be available at the end of each class, so you can prepare for the next meeting). We will have extra sheets at the Brea store when you sign up for class.
