

Bunny Pillow Wrap Diane Beckman Moore's of Brea Saturday, March 16th 9:15 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.



Supply List:

- * Embroidery Machine, accessories, sewing attachments
- * Hoop size 8" x 12" minimum
- * No Show Mesh Stabilizer. Cut to 32" long USB to put embroidery files onto Fabric for project - Cotton prints Heat N Bond Lite, Quilt batting
- * Embroidery thread Colors to coordinate with fabric. Colors for flowers & butterfly Velcro or buttons to close wrap around pillow Scissors, appliqué scissors, rotary cutter with blade and ruler, cutting mat
- * Medium weight woven iron on interfacing. I use SF101 interfacing. Iron onto back center panel fabric, appliqué pieces, outer border fabric This will give project the firmness it needs.

Precut Fabric - Quality cotton is best. Make a white, gray or brown bunny. Numbered items to cut fabric pieces below. Bring extra fabric in case you need it!

- 1. Background panel. I used white on white print. 11" x 32"
- 2. Outer ears 4" x 6-1/2" / arms 4" x 4 1/2" / legs 4" x 6" or one large piece of fabric. Gray fabric or color of choice
- 3. Inner ear, pink fabric or felt 3-1/2" x 5"

Purchase a pillow measuring 13 -14" x 19 - 20".

- 4. Body 8-1/2" x 6", gray fabric or color of choice
- 5. Narrow strip 1-1/2" x 32", green border or color of choice
- 6. Wide strip 2-3/4" x 32", yellow fabric or color of choice
- 7. Background 13" x 32"
- 8. Pillow Cover 10" x 20" times 2 for back 14" x 20" for front
- 9. Quilt batting 11" x 32
