Supply List

- *Embroidery Machine & accessories
- *Sewing assembly, needle, presser foot
- *Hoop best size is 8" x 12"
- *Cut Away or No Show Mesh stabilizer to fit your hoop
- *3 4 coordinating prints for basket
- *SF101 woven interfacing or fusible woven stabilizer adhere to fabric
- *Pellon stabilizer fusible #809 OR sew in #40 (I prefer the #40)
- *Embroidery thread Colors to match your fabric choice
- *Sewing thread Color to match your fabric colors. Remember to bring a bobbin!
- *Sewing pins or clips
- *Scissors
- *Rotary cutter with blade and ruler
- *Cutting mat

Fabrics - See instructions below on how to prepare fabric BEFORE class.

Please do not forget your hoop, power cord, sewing attachment and sewing pedal!

Prepare Fabric before class:

Choose 3 - 4 Coordinating prints

One will be for lining of basket, it can be the same as one of the outside fabrics or different.

Pre-shrink fabric if you prefer

Press fabric if necessary

Top Band

Cut two 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" and cut two 5" x 2-1/2" pieces of fabric

Middle Band

Cut two 8-1/2" x 5" and cut two 5" x 5" pieces of fabric

Bottom Band

Cut two 8-1/2" x 4 1/2" and cut two 5" x 4 1/2" pieces of fabric

Lining


Cut two 11-1/4" x 9" pieces of fabric. Cut out a 2" corner from bottom corners.

Use one of the side fabrics or a coordinating fabric

Sew In Interfacing/Stabilizer (to give basket shape)

I like Pellon #40

Cut two 11-1/2" x 9" pieces and two 11-1/2" x 5-1/2"



Adhere SF101 interfacing or woven stabilizer to back of fabric if you want to give fabric some shape. (I find this helps keep fabric from puckering when embroidered.)

Learn how to create most of the basket in the hoop. Add an Embroidery design to project.

Finished size approximately 8" x 4" x 7"
