# **Supply List:**

- \*Pattern: "Cathedral Window Flag" ©2017 Jennifer Bosworth (Shabby Fabrics.com)
- \*Fabric required:
  - Bases: (5) Blues ⅓ yard each
    - (2) Creams 1 yard each
    - (2) Reds 1½ yards each
  - Windows: (5) Creams scraps (for stars)
    - (2) Creams 1/4 yard each (for cream stripes)
    - (2) Reds 1/4 yard each (for red stripes
- \*Rotary Cutter, 24" Ruler, and Mat
- \*Sewing Thread to match fabrics
- \*Regular Sewing Foot
- \*1/4 Inch Foot
- \*Open Toe Foot
- \*Roxanne Glue-Baste-It (or something similar)
- \*Basic Sewing Supplies
- \*Sewing Machine in good working order

## **Prior to Class:**

## CUT:

#### Bases:

From each of (5) Blues, cut: (4) 10" x 10" squares

From each of (2) Creams, cut: (12) 10" x 10" squares

From each of (2) Reds, cut: (17) 10" x 10" squares

### Windows:

From each of 5 Creams, cut: (7) 2½" x 2½" squares for stars

From each Cream 1 and Red 1, cut: (23) 21/8" x 21/8" squares

From each Cream 2, cut (20) 2½" x 2½" squares

From each Red 2, cut (30) 21/2" x 21/2" squares

If you do not have time to cut all the fabric, please try to cut the blue 10" x 10" squares AND the Cream  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for the stars. We will start with the blue area in the first class.

**NOTE:** Instead of using (5) Blue fabrics for the bases, you can use all the same or all different. You need to have 20 blue squares. Also, for the Cream Windows for the Stars, you can use the same Cream. You will need 35 Cream Windows. My goal is to finish the blue section in the first class. We will work on the stripes in the second class.
