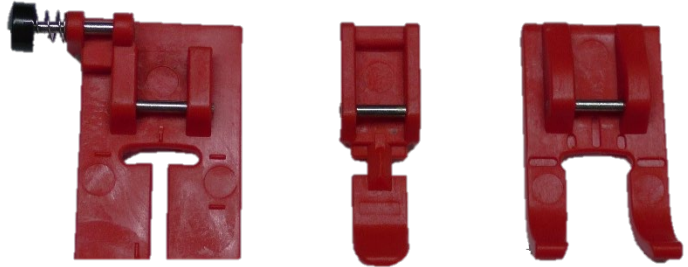


UltraT™ Set #2 for Brother/Baby Lock

- Bi-Level Foot
- Narrow Zipper Foot
- Open Toe Foot



Open Toe Foot

The open toe foot offers maximum visibility for precision sewing. The shape of this foot is based on the metal open toe foot and not the clear plastic foot included with many machines. The specialty composite material reduces friction when sewing and allows both dense decorative stitches and lateral stitches to flow without distortion. The wide opening in front of the needle exposes the complete sewing field for precision placement. Embossed on the foot behind the needle are markings for left, center and right needle positions. Marks on the left and right are marks to indicate the needle depth. A deep groove on the underside of the foot allows the raised portion of decorative stitches to pass under the foot easily.



Suggested uses:

Decorative stitching of difficult fabrics such as velvet and vinyl.

40 mm lateral stitches on any material.

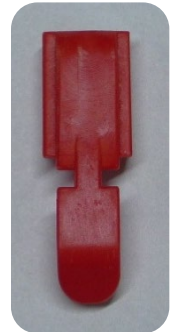
Dense decorative stitches with a high profile such as candle wicking stitches.

Applications requiring precise placement.

Tapering Stitches for placement and selecting taper location while stitching.

Narrow Zipper Foot

The narrow zipper foot is ideal for close seams next to bulky or thick items such as cording or zippers. This foot has one connection point to the ankle of the machine as opposed to the plastic zipper foot with two connection points that is included with many machines. Check needle position before sewing with this foot! The center needle position is not compatible with this foot. Select a left (0.0) or a right (7.0) needle positions to place the needle outside the profile of the foot. The needle position is adjustable within XXXXX mm. Because the foot presses on only the center feed dogs and the low resistance composite material, this foot is very maneuverable in tight curves.



Suggested uses:

Precision sewing close to zippers or cording.

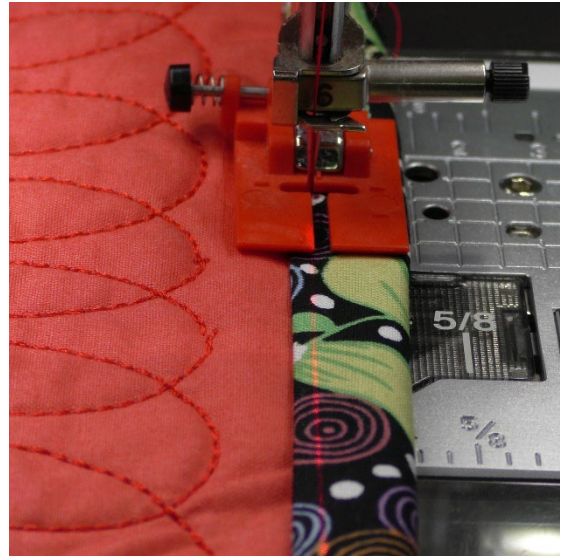
Topstitching using width of foot as guide.

Stitching in small spaces where a larger profile foot will not work.

Stitching extreme curves in soft sculpture or glove making.

Bi-Level Foot

Designed for machine sewing bindings on quilts, the bi-level foot has many other practical uses. It looks very much like the standard “J” foot with a leveling button and similar profile. The underside has a thick side and thinner side. The top of the foot has raised markings for center needle position, needle depth, ¼” from front of needle and edge location of thicker sole. Markings are designed to place stitching 1/8” from folded edge of binding when using center needle



position and placing folded edge along marked thicker sole. The wide opening allows for needle placement in any needle position and many decorative stitches up to 7.0 mm in width. The composite material reduces friction and prevents shifting of the binding in all directions during stitching. The bi-level sole allows the foot to sit flat when stitching over any application with thicker and thinner areas such as applique over the edge of vinyl or stitch-in-the-ditch next to very bulky seams of polar fleece or velvet. Because this foot reduces lateral movement, this foot is not recommended for decorative stitches wider than 7.0 mm.

Suggested uses:

Machine stitching binding on quilts.

Applique of vinyl or other bulky materials.

Stitch-in-the-ditch for a bulky/flat fabric such as polar fleece or Minky™ to cotton.

Top stitch polar fleece or denim seams.
